

The Wheels for the World ™ Harvest Project program seeks to partner with and give wheelchairs to organizations that minister to people affected by disability in less-resourced countries.

Process

- Complete the Harvest Project application form and return via mail, email or fax
- Describe your capacity to provide wheelchairs in less resourced countries of the world
- Upon approval, applicants will be notified of next steps

Criteria

- Faith-based mission
- Valid non-profit status
- Ability to coordinate and fund transportation of wheelchairs domestically and internationally
- Qualified Physical and/or Occupational Therapist to appropriately fit recipients to wheelchairs

Agreement

- Appropriately seat recipients in wheelchairs
- Share the Gospel with each wheelchair recipient, caregiver, and family
- Facilitate inclusion into community and the church through ongoing care and support
- Provide outcome report and photos to *Wheels for the World* TM

- Team formation, training, and support
- Disability awareness and resources
- Training with *Wheels for the World* TM staff
- Participation in a *Wheels for the World* TM Outreach

Important Notes

- Donations of unrestored wheelchairs are welcomed.
- Once logistical arrangements are made, it is *critical* to follow through with scheduled deadlines, especially when picking up wheelchairs from prison restoration centers. If deadlines are missed, donated wheelchairs may be forfeited.



Donation Agreement

Parties

The agreement below is between Joni and Friends (JAF) and the non-profit organization

Organization name

Background and Purpose

JAF has offered to donate wheelchairs, and other mobility equipment (walkers, canes, and crutches) ("Donated Goods") as available to Donee. Donee wishes to accept such goods for ultimate distribution to the people affected by disability internationally. These two parties wish to set forth their mutual agreements and understandings respecting the donations intended to be made.

Agreement

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the parties hereby set forth the following terms of agreement for the intended donations.

1. Use of Goods

- Donee agrees to use the Donated Goods solely for projects within its organization relating to its tax-exempt purpose and solely for the needy and people with disabilities.
- 1.2 Donee agrees not to offer for sale, sell, transfer or barter the Donated Goods by JAF in exchange for money, other properties, or services unless written consent is received from JAF.
- 1.3 Donated Goods must be distributed by Donee to those in need, free of charge.
- 1.4 Donated Goods must be shipped or distributed internationally and may not be distributed within the United States of America.
- Donee agrees to abide by any restrictions on use or distribution of Donated Goods, geographical or otherwise, as required by JAF and communicated in writing to Donee by JAF.
- Donee agrees to utilize physical or occupational therapists, or other licensed medical professionals having sufficient training and expertise in evaluation, for the proper fitting and adjusting of Donated Goods.



2. Disclaimer of Warranties

Donee acknowledges that all Donated Goods received from JAF are accepted by Donee in "as-is" condition and JAF makes no warranty, covenant, or representation, expressed or implied, regarding the Donated Goods, including without limitation, their design or condition or fitness for any particular purpose. JAF shall not be liable for any direct or consequential damages or losses suffered or incurred by you or a third party resulting from the use of the Donated Goods.

Donee agrees and understands that it is responsible for the correct storage and use of the Donated Goods, in accordance with which the Donee waives any and all claims against JAF and releases JAF from all liability associated with the use of the Donated Goods.

3. Reserved Rights of JAF

Donee understands and agrees that JAF reserves the right at any time, in its good faith discretion, to rescind or modify this agreement or forbid Donee from receiving further donations from JAF.

4. Indemnification

Donee hereby agrees to hold JAF harmless of any action, suits of law or in equity, or any obligation whatsoever arising out of or attributed to any action by the Donee in connection with its storage, use or transfer of the items supplied to it by JAF.

The undersigned hereby warrants that he/she is an authorized agent of the party whose name appears below, and by his/her signature does hereby bind it to the terms, conditions, and limitations of this agreement.
